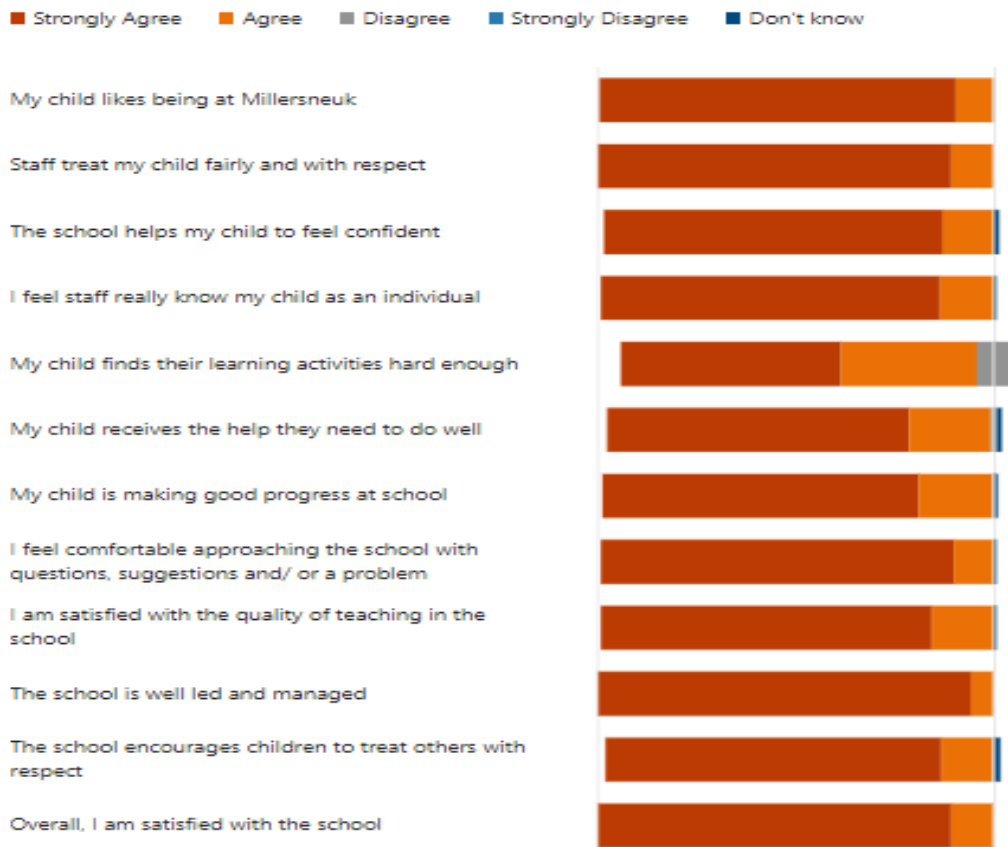




How Good is Our School?

What are Millersneuk's Main Strengths?

- ✓ Family feel. Supportive staff.
- ✓ It is a great community. Staff know the pupils well. Parents are involved in the school. Great communication with parents. Thanks for all your hard work at making Millersneuk a great school.
- ✓ A positive community with a nurturing attitude towards learning.
- ✓ Working with children to advance.
- ✓ The teachers are so good with the children and I personally feel as a parent I could approach our teachers and staff with any questions or worries I may have It's so inclusive as a school and just a happy environment to be in.
- ✓ The leadership, the school community, sense of fun.
- ✓ Creating a happy and supportive space for learning.
- ✓ Real "family" feel, with senior management team being extremely approachable, very hands-on, and taking an active role in leading others within the school. Excellent communication with parents on a range of matters, both big and small.

What Do You Feel Millersneuk Needs to Improve On?

- ✓ No improvements needed (x 25 parents)
- ✓ There's a lot of different platforms and services that they use, and it can be hard to keep up with all the different logins etc you need to use. I don't imagine this is just a Millersneuk problem though, I imagine it's across Scotland. Also, it can be hard to keep up with all the messages/emails coming through.
- ✓ Maybe more transparency on what the children are working on in class. Just so parents can better support at home.
- ✓ I would like to see my daughter pushed more academically.
- ✓ Maybe more outdoor activities/teaching time if possible.
- ✓ More staff awareness around neuro-divergence and accessibility to the educational psychologist.
- ✓ I am extremely happy with how the school works.
- ✓ I would be good for parents to see who teachers are ahead of transitioning into a new year via a picture on a newsletter possibly. Nothing to fancy just would be good to put a face to the name.
- ✓ Keep doing what you're doing!
- ✓ There could be more homework for pupils to do if they wanted it and some work that could be given during the summer break, again not compulsory but for parents that would like this option.
- ✓ Absolutely nothing. Keep up the good work!
- ✓ Perhaps give a little more notice on events such as discos to allow parents to plan especially for those who commute to work out of Glasgow.
- ✓ I feel I can't really comment on where to improve as I've never felt the lack of anything.
- ✓ Before or after school clubs.
- ✓ A refresh of sports day.
- ✓ I would like parents evening to be a bit longer. maybe (if possible) split this over 2 or 3 weeks. A few more lunch or after school activities.
- ✓ Millersneuk has a strong focus on continuous improvement and engagement, often inviting views and being responsive - any improvement opportunities are captured through these channels - and acted in as appropriate - thank you.
- ✓ Nothing, I honestly believe it is an excellent school.
- ✓ Possibly more after school activities?
- ✓ Great steps have been taken on STEM in the last year but this needs to continue. As we come out of the pandemic it would be nice to have whole year group learning experiences.
- ✓ At this moment none. It's just an amazing school!
- ✓ I honestly can't think of a way the school could do better unless they were gifted a multi-million pound budget!
- ✓ There is a lack of classroom support staff in the older years of the school for those who need it. We also appreciate this is difficult within budget restrictions.
- ✓ My son really enjoyed his recent field trips so it would be great if there was more. Could they incorporate some sports teams with training before/after school?
- ✓ Nothing. Fabulous school!
- ✓ They have just recently changed the classes round, meaning that this has impacted on child's sense of wellbeing, which isn't great as most of the boys in his class, (his main support unit for the past 3 years), have been put into the other class, which isn't great and seems very unfair.
- ✓ It would be great if Millersneuk could have an extension and have more space indoor for the activities.
- ✓ No very happy with school.
- ✓ Outdoor learning.
- ✓ N/A - I find it a very supportive and excellent school.
- ✓ I can't think of anything, keep going the way you are!
- ✓ More consistency with the quality of school meals.
- ✓ If I had to pick something, I'd say a little bit on promoting kindness and ensuring the children know the affects that their words can have on others.
- ✓ Behaviour by certain individuals appears to be, maybe not allowed but in certain cases not dealt with. I understand that is subjective. Far too much sexualisation that my child comes home with for her age. Rainbow kissing is worth a Google. I had never heard that expression before.
- ✓ Don't know much about what is done for children with particular needs, e.g. friends school had dyslexia awareness week and children were offered dyslexia screening and further assessment if indicated. I haven't heard of the school offering anything in this line of thinking and it would be good to catch things early and help support children with particular needs at the earliest opportunity.

- ✓ Hard to respond as much of what I'd say is driven by the government rather than the school but I do think the building is cramped, not fully fit for purpose and tired and I'd love to see better facilities which would lead to wider opportunities for the kids.
- ✓ I don't think I have sufficient knowledge/insight to answer that.
- ✓ While I understand the reasons for it, I do feel the homework in P1 has been quite extensive and we've not always managed to complete it all.
- ✓ I can't really fault it, I think it's an amazing school with great staff and a great leader.
- ✓ Nothing I think you are doing great.
- ✓ The school could do with upgrading, but that's not the schools fault! More opportunities for after school activities / clubs would be good.
- ✓ More consistency in quality of teaching. There are some excellent teachers but not all provide good pace and challenge for pupils.
- ✓ School dinners - but this is a government funding issue.
- ✓ Nothing but the council should update the building soon.
- ✓ I would be scraping the barrel for an issue for the sake of having an issue. I can't think of improvements that need made.
- ✓ The Facilities.
- ✓ I would prefer learning assemblies to take place in the evening to make it possible to attend. Homework activities could be more streamlined and clearer to understand what is expected to be completed.
- ✓ Just some concerns when a teacher goes off and teacher who covers sometimes doesn't hear if my child asks questions/relies on other children to help. Understand teachers also are human/have families and need to take time off but my child struggled when this was a long term replacement.
- ✓ School meals - poor consistency in portion size and availability of stated menus. It needs a cooking kitchen!
- ✓ The school overall hasn't a lot it needs to improve on.
- ✓ Providing a more varied and challenging learning environment. I feel the school churn the same thing out year after year. They have some very talented pupils and should be pushing them to do the best of their ability.
- ✓ Keep up the good work!
- ✓ Seesaw could be used more to let parents see more of the children's learning to allow conversations to be opened up.
- ✓ New playground equipment would be nice. Some teachers having more of an understanding of ADHD and how it is expressed/ masked with different children.
- ✓ More challenging curriculum.
- ✓ Nothing from parents pov! P2 pupil input would be to find a regular way for other year groups to interact, she enjoyed PE sessions where her class took part with another year group for example
- ✓ Being more proactive in dealing with bullies, separate carers have expressed their concerns about the same individual. My child reports their concerns and I give them ways to defend themselves without insulting the child
- ✓ Better communication throughout the term on homework and what is required from parents.
- ✓ At times the rotation of office for eco committee etc could have been better with students serving more than once over different years. Having system where students who have previously served step aside to allow others the chance might be good.
- ✓ Air-conditioning. The number of events is encouraging for the children but as a full time working mum can be hard to keep up with all the emails and comms. I'm glad I live across from school!
- ✓ My child is struggling with school at the moment especially socially. More support with the social dynamics of the class would benefit her greatly.
- ✓ This is a minor observation. There is at times a lack of consideration of equity. Particularly around the amount of non-uniform days during the year. This can put pressure on parents and pupils alike. One of my children has felt particularly pressured to dress and look a certain way.
- ✓ Providing fruit and veg at lunch.
- ✓ Nothing staff related. Possibly building modernization but I love the smaller school cohesiveness. I have some concern that a building modernization plan would lead to larger numbers.
- ✓ They have just recently changed the classes round, meaning that this has impacted on child's sense of wellbeing, which isn't great as most of the boys in his class, (his main support unit for the past 3 years), have been put into the other class, which isn't great and seems very unfair.
- ✓ Afterschool group within the school. Competitive traditional sports day so those more sporty children have their chance to shine just like academics who are in 'top' groups.
- ✓ Class communication could perhaps be better but I generally feel the school do a very good job.
- ✓ I feel the school dinners could do with better more child friendly choices.
- ✓ School needs modernised/upgraded.
